


Create a Cross Stitch Design

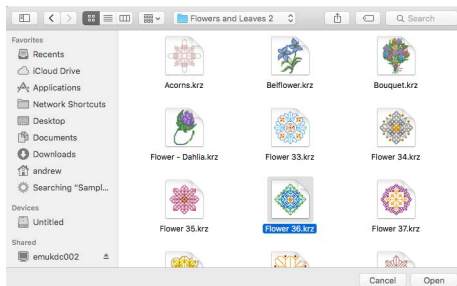
Load a design, then draw a multiplied pattern around it.



Note: Before running this demo, use Reset All Apps in PREMIER+™ 2 Configure.

Note: PREMIER+™ 2 Cross Stitcher is part of PREMIER+™ 2 ULTRA.

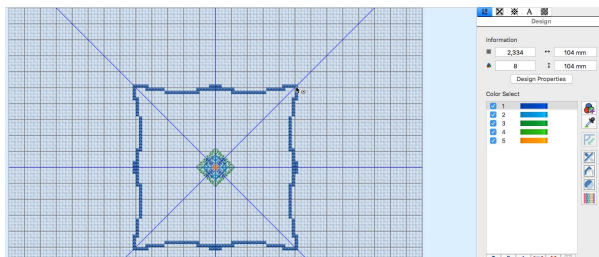
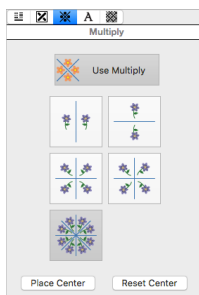
- 1 Open PREMIER+™ 2 Cross Stitcher .
The Cross Stitch Design Assistant opens at the Design Options page.
- 2 Click Start a New Cross Stitch Design with no Picture, then click Continue.
- 3 The design will use the default settings, so click Done to close the assistant.
- 4 Choose File > Insert.
Note: Ensure that Icons are selected.
- 5 Browse to Home/Premier+2/Samples/
Cross/KRZ Sampler/Flowers and Leaves 2.
- 6 Select one of the numbered symmetric
flower designs, for example Flower 36.krz.
- 7 Click Open to load the flower in the
center of the design area.
- 8 Control-click and choose Finish Box Select
in the Context menu.








Note: All of the colors used by the flower
design are now displayed in the Design window  of the Control Panel .

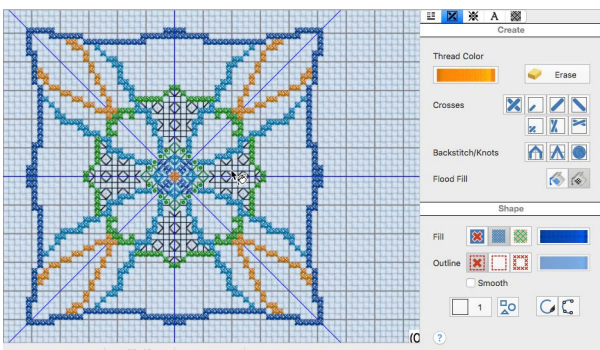
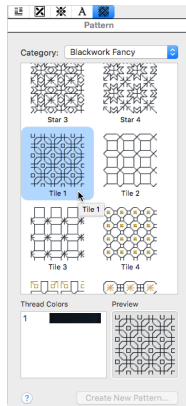
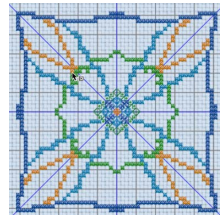
Create a Multiplied pattern around the cross stitch flower

- 9 Select the Multiply window  of the Control Panel .
- 10 Click Use Multiply , then click Reflect 8-Way .
Eight Multiply lines crossing each other appear on the design area.

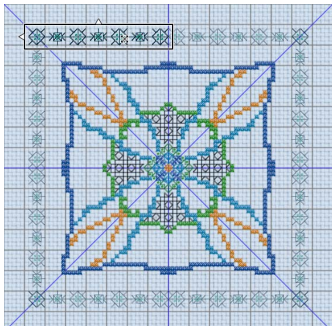
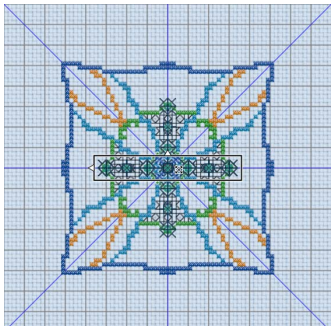


- 11 Select the Design window  of the Control Panel .

- 12 Click the top color in the Color Select. This becomes the color for drawing.
- 13 Place the pointer on the vertical Multiply line about 4 large grid squares above the top of the flower.
- 14 Drag to draw a line to the right, to touch the next blue Multiply line.
Note: Don't worry if the line wobbles, this will add more interest to the design.
- 15 Click to select a contrasting color in the Design Panel.
- 16 Draw a second line below the first, and sloping downwards to create a more rounded shape.
- 17 Click to select another contrasting color in the Design Panel.
- 18 Draw a line from the outer circle to the flower.
- 19 Choose yet another color and draw a line from the outer circle to meet its reflection at the edge of the inner circle.
- 20 Select the Pattern window  of the Control Panel .
- 21 In the Category pop-up menu, choose Blackwork Fancy.
- 22 Select a dense decorative pattern from the Pattern display.
- 23 Select the Create window  of the Control Panel .
- 24 Click Pattern Flood Fill .



- 25 Click inside the area between the flower and the inner circle that you drew.
The area is filled with the pattern you selected.
Note: Choose Edit > Undo and try again in another area if you didn't like the effect.
- 26 Choose File > Insert.
- 27 Browse to /Home/Premier+2/Samples/Cross/KRZ Sampler/Borders.



- 28 Select one of the borders and click Open.
- 29 Drag the border upwards and to the left.
- 30 Place the border so that it forms a frame when touching other reflected copies.
Note: If the border piece is too small, or too large, choose Edit > Undo twice to remove the border from the design area, then select another border with Insert.
- 31 Control-click and choose Finish Box Select in the Context menu to place the border.
- 32 View the finished design in the Design Player ▶ or Life View 🎨.
