

PREMIER +[™] EXTRA - ExpressDesign Wizard Appliqué Demo

Learn to use the ExpressDesign Wizard to create a beautiful appliqué. It's so quick and easy! You can audition your appliqué fabric right in the hoop.

Create Appliqué Tulip 1 - ExpressDesign Wizard

First, use Reset All Modules in PREMIER+ $^{\text{M}}$ Configure to ensure that all settings are at their original point.



- Double-click to open the Premier+ Embroidery System
- 2. Select the **View** tab.
- 3. Click Change Hoop.
- 4. In Hoop Group ensure that Universal is selected.
- 5. Click Hoop Size and choose 100mm x 100mm Universal Square Hoop.
- 6. Set Orientation to Natural.

 The natural orientation is how the hoop will clip on your embroidery machine.
- 7. Click the **OK** button.
- 8. Ensure that grid size is set to 10 mm and set to Show Grid. Size 10 mm
- 9. Select the **Wizards** tab. Wizards
- 10. Click the ExpressDesign drop-down arrow.
- 11. Click ExpressDesign Into Rectangle. ExpressDesign Into Rectangle
- 12. Click, hold, and drag a box one grid square from the upper left corner to within one grid square of the lower right corner.
- 13. Release the mouse button and the wizard will appear.
- 14. In the Choose Design Type window, click the Create Express Border option. Ocreate Express Border
- 15. Click the **Next** button.
- 16. In the Choose Picture window, click the **Load a Picture** button.
- 17. In the Premier+ folder, click on the + next to Samples.
- 18. Click on the + next to the Premier+ Lessons folder.
- 19. Click on the Create folder to open it.
- 20. Click on Tulip.png.
- 21. Click the **OK** button.

 You could also upload photos or graphics directly from your social media pages.





- 22. Click the **Next** button.
- 23. In the Rotate and Crop Picture window, click the Next button.
- 24. In the Monochrome Threshold window, click the **Next** button.
- 25. In the Express Border Options window, Satin Line is chosen by default.
- 26. Click the **Stitch Options...** button.

Stitch Options...

- 27. Change the line width to 3.0 mm.
- 28. Click the **OK** button.


Create Appliqué Tulip 2 – Add Floral Appliqué

29. Ensure that the **Appliqué** button is selected. The Appliqué icon will be highlighted and you will see fabric in the preview window.





- 31. In the Appliqué Type box, click the Fabric option.
- 32. In the Fabric Options box, click the **Load Previously Saved Fabric** button.
- 33. At the pop-up fabric viewer window, click the + button beside the General folder.
- 34. Click Floral. Flora
- 35. Click Floral Mixed 1 01.
- 36. Click the **OK** button.
- 37. If desired, change the Angle.
- 38. Click the **OK** button.
- 39. Click the Appliqué Options... button.



40. For the Appliqué Method, click the Pre-cut Piece option. Pre-cut Piece

The Pre-cut piece option is used when you are using an automatic cutter or cutwork needles.

The margin of 1.0mm is perfect so that the pre-cut piece is just barely stitched down with a double stitch and will be covered with the satin stitch.

The proper placement and stitch down lines plus stops and finishing options will be created depending upon the option chosen.

- 41. Click the **OK** button.
- 42. Click the Thread Color Change button.
- 43. Click the purple color in the 2nd row, 3rd column.
- 44. Click the **OK** button.
- 45. Click the **Finish** button.
- 46. Select the File tab.





48. Name your file Tulip Applique.

The file will save in the .vp4 format, which will retain all the appliqué design information even after you save.

- 49. Click the **Save** button. Save
 50. Select the **File** tab.
- 51. Click Export Appliqué Pieces. Export Appliqué Pieces

This will save the appliqué shapes for your cutter, cutwork needles, as a template, or to print appliqué pieces.

- 52. Choose the format for your cutter.
- 53. Click the **OK** button.
- 54. In the Save As window, the software remembers the name from the design for the appliqué piece.
- 55. Click the **Save** button. Save

 56. Go back to the **File** tab.
- 57. Click the **Export** button.
- 58. Click the drop-down list to select the appropriate File Format for your embroidery machine.



- 59. Click the format of your choice.
- 6o. Click the **OK** button.

Notice that the software remembers the name the design was given and automatically added the word Exported at the end.

61. Click the **Export** button. Export
